

Budget for the financial year ending 31 July 2024

We expect the new Church Year to remain uncertain and challenging. The church has therefore adopted a prudent approach to its Budget, making sure there is no excessive spending post pandemic, saving and spending wisely yet investing intentionally to growing God's Kingdom.

With Covid-19 being endemic, the church has resumed all worship services, ministries, outreach programmes and activities onsite. Prudent as we may be, the operating expenditure is budgeted at \$19.6m and this is before accounting for depreciation cost: This is 16% higher than the current year's forecast and primarily due to escalating costs that are beyond our control. Included in the budget is about \$1m of new initiatives and this includes our support and partnership with MWS in the new nursing home at Eunos. The live streaming and online ministry engagement will continue to be the platform to reach out to a wider community. As such, the church will continue to invest in new digital technologies and equipping our congregation with intentional discipleship tools.



We are budgeting an income of about \$20m. This will help cover our cash Opex but not depreciation. We therefore expect to close FY23/24 with a deficit of \$2.1m after providing for depreciation of \$2.5m.
