5th Sunday of a month, before finally committing to monthly service after a year.

Over the past 5 years, it has been a meaningful experience. We get to interact with many different people

speaking different languages, dialects, and religions. The opportunity to serve has enabled us to look outwards -

beyond ourselves. We learnt about different societal issues and strengthen our bond as family in Christ when we

serve others.

and His glory. It has taught us to count our blessings more and to find joy in the everyday things in life.

It also encourages us to share about Jesus with the non-believing seniors and reel in joyful exchanges of knowing

get up immediately. Lie in bed for a little while more, embrace the moment and say a little prayer to give thanks to

God with joy for this brand new day you are going to embark on!"

To the young adults amongst us, we would say to pray about it and trust that God will lead you, and equip you,

more abundantly than you can ever imagine.

Just take the first step to volunteer and join!
